### **What Will I Study?**

All A Levels are now linear and therefore fully assessed at the end of year 13. Students will therefore choose three A levels from the subjects we offer to study over the two years. For some students with exceptionally high GCSE grades there will be the option of choosing a fourth A Level. This would be decided on a case-by-case basis on GCSE results day. From this academic year, we will be offering the Extended Project Qualification (EPQ) at Level Three.

### **What Are The Entry Requirements?**

To study A Levels at St Paul's students will need to achieve a minimum of a grade 5 in English and Maths and a grade 5 in three other subjects. For some subjects, including Maths, Science, and Psychology, there will be additional requirements.
