What next?

Before you begin any applications you need to complete information within 'Your Profile' Click into 'Update your details'



Information Required

You need to work through each of the sections to fill in missing information about yourself – start in the Personal Details section and work through each one. Some of the information is already preloaded Please fill in ALL the missing information.

Each section will turn green after you've filled out all of the necessary information. Once they are all green, you can click 'back to your account'

Your predicted grades will be automatically uploaded into the Qualifications section

Once your personal statement has been checked by your form tutor, copy and paste it into the Personal Statement section

Starting your application
