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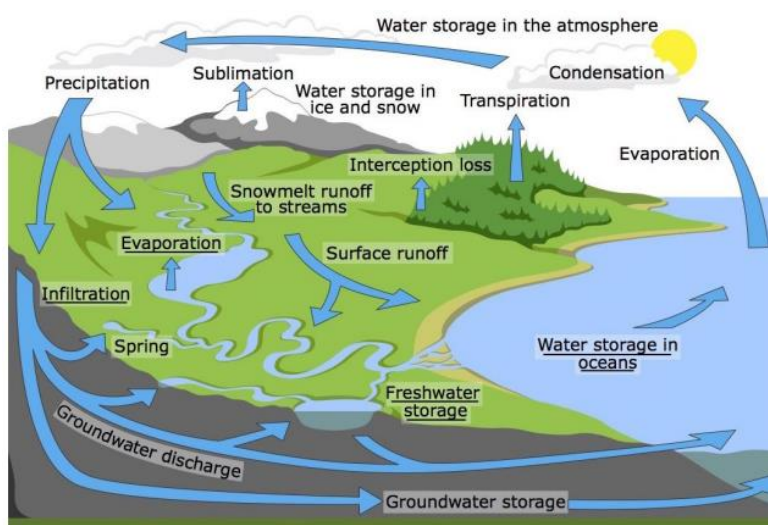

3. What links exist between the water and carbon cycles?

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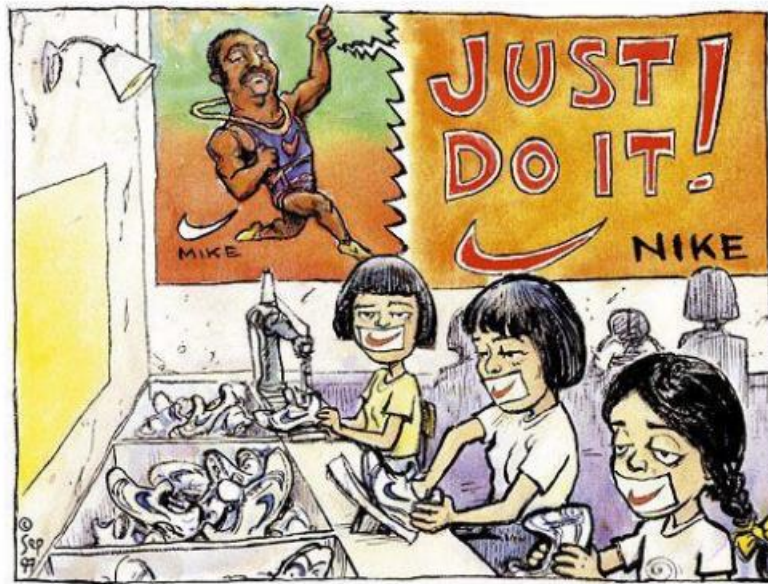
